DUAL OPTIONS

As a part of the city's Education Compact with Miami-Dade County Public Schools, the city is offering college classes to students at Miami Beach Senior High, Nautilus Middle School and Fienberg Fisher K-8 through Florida International University (FIU) and Miami Dade College (MDC).

WHAT IS DUAL ENROLLMENT?

Dual enrollment allows students to begin accumulating college credits at no cost while still in high school and middle school. With dual enrollment, students can work towards graduating from college on time or even early, saving their families up to \$150,000.

IS THIS FOR MY CHILD?

Make sure your child is ready to meet the demanding coursework that a college class requires. Dual enrollment courses are for college credit and appear on your child's permanent college transcript.

Requirements:

- Entering or currently in grades 8, 9, 10, 11, or 12
- 3.0 unweighted grade point average
- Meet all college/university requirements
